

## NOTES TO EXHIBITIORS 參展商須知

#### 1. Show Venue and Table Set Up 展覽場地及佈置

The Hong Kong Coin Show (HKCS) will take place from Monday, 9th October to Wednesday, 11th October 2023 on 18/F, The Mira Hotel at 118 Nathan Road, Tsim Sha Tsui, Kowloon, Hong Kong. The set up starts from 08:00 on and the show finishes at 19:00 (Day 1) / 18:00 (Day 2 & 3). All tables must be open untill the stipulated time.

香港國際錢幣聯合展銷會(HKCS)將於2023年10月9日(星期一)至2023年10月11日(星期三)於九龍尖沙咀彌敦道118號美麗華酒店18樓舉行。參展商可於展覽期內每日上午八時起佈置場地,展銷會於下午七時(第一天)/六時(第二及第三天)結束。所有攤位必須開放至清場時間

#### 2. Exhibitor Badges 參展商名牌

Exhibitor badges will be issued to all exhibitors and their registered assistants. All badges holders must wear their badge while working at their tables. All badges cannot be sold, transferred, leased or shared to / with other dealers without pior consent of the organizers. 每位参展商及其已登記之助手均配有名牌。在會場內,所有參展商及助手必須佩戴其名牌。所有名牌不得出售、轉姐、或租借給非參展商。

#### 3. Bourse Table 展位

The bourse tables in general are 6 feet long and 2 feet wide. Each table will have two exhibit show cases (800mmx500mmx97mm) which must be placed on the bourse table horizontally (parellel to the long ledge of the table). All aisles and walkways should be kept clear of displays. Occupation of a vacated table without the consent of the HKCS management is forbidden and will lead to expulsion from the show permanently. 一般攤位的尺寸為6英尺長2英尺闊。每個攤位將配有兩個展櫃(800毫米x500毫米x97毫米),展櫃必須橫放於攤位枱上。參展商須確保展櫃不會佔用行人通道。未經HKCS管理層同意,任何人士不得佔用空置攤位,違者不得再參與HKCS。

#### 4. Promotion in the Venue 場內宣傳

Persons without the official HKCS adge selling or advertising directly to the public entrances will be expelled and debarred from future entrance. Exhibitors are not allowed to place any promotional materials like banners or pull-up banners in the show venue, except with the permission of HKCS committee.

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


## FLOOR PLAN 大會平面圖



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
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


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# 設計雕刻之美 展現石窟藝術精華

What makes a gold or silver coin beautiful? What kind of beauty can make you fall in love with a coin?

"Beauty is in the eye of the beholder".

As collectors have different cultural backgrounds and interests, they also have preferences in judging the beauty of gold and silver coins.

As far as the author is concerned, a beautiful gold and silver coin should have the following characteristics:

就筆者而言,一枚美的金銀幣應該有以下幾個特徵:

One is the exquisite mold engraving process. Gold and silver coins themselves are relief art, and the engraving process of a beautiful gold and silver coin must be eye-catching. The smooth, mirror-like base shines with an attractive golden light, the high reliefs show the beauty of three-dimensional art, and the delicate sandblasting is like jade fat. The exquisite engraving makes the mysterious gold and silver material exude a fascinating artistic atmosphere, which makes people fascinated and unable to stop.

The second is the exquisite detailing. Gold and silver coins are not only relief art, but also micro-carving art. Lifelike characters, animals, and stories are engraved on the surface of a coin that is two to three centimeters square, and the height of the relief is only between 0.2 and 0.4 millimeters. Under this limitation, a beautiful gold or silver coin should be able to depict in minute detail the demeanor of the characters, the texture of the skin, and the plaques of the window grilles of the buildings. The vividness of the details not only enhances the artistic expression and infectious power of the coin, but is also a great attraction to collectors. Appreciating these details is like exploring the treasures of the world of microscopic art. Each time you view a coin, you will discover something you never noticed before and be excited by the details that you never noticed before.

一是精美的細節錶現。金銀幣不僅是浮雕藝術,更是微雕藝術。在二三厘米見方的幣面上刻畫出栩栩如生的人物、動物、故事畫面,浮雕高度僅在0.2~0.4毫米之間。在這種限制下,一枚美的金銀幣,應該要能夠細致入微地刻畫出人物的神態、肌膚的紋理、建築的窗柵匾文。細節的生動刻畫,不僅會增強錢幣的藝術錶現力和感染力,對收藏者也是一種巨大吸引力。欣賞這些細節,就好像在探尋微觀藝術世界的寶藏,每鑒賞一次,都會發現之前從未註意的地方,併會被這些未曾註意到的細節所振奮。

Thirdly, deep cultural connotation. For a beautiful gold and silver coin, the subject matter it represents should have deep cultural connotation. If it is said that the exquisite carving and fine details are the delicate face and gorgeous clothes of a beautiful person, then the cultural connotation of the subject matter is the soul of this beautiful person. When the collector tastes the cultural connotation behind a beautiful gold and silver coin, the coin is no longer a cold object for the collector, but has a soul, and the deep cultural connotation is the profound thought of the coin. The longer the coin is savored, the more it is perfumed. The exquisite carving can be surpassed, and the fine details can be familiarized without being seen, but only the culture is the soul of a beautiful coin that will never be worn out.

一 是深厚的文化內涵。一枚美的金銀幣,它所錶現的題材應該是有深厚文化內涵的。如果說精湛的雕刻和精美的細節是金銀幣這位佳人精致的容顏和華麗衣裳的話,那麽題材的文化內涵則是這位佳人的靈魂。品一枚美的金銀幣,當收藏者品味它背後的文化內涵時,這枚錢幣對於收藏者來說就不再是一個冰冷的物體,而是有了靈魂,深厚的文化內涵就是這枚幣深邃的思想。品之愈久,香之愈彌。精湛的雕刻可以被超越,精美的細節可以熟而無睹,唯有文化才是一枚美的幣永不磨滅的靈魂。

In 2001, the People's Bank of China started to issue gold and silver commemorative coins on the art of China's grottoes, starting with the Dunhuang Grottoes, followed by the Longmen Grottoes, then the Maijishan Grottoes, and ending with the Yungang Grottoes. Four major grottoes, a 10-year span, 18 varieties, 10 gold and 8 silver, exquisite carvings, profound details, and deep cultural connotations of the Chinese cave art gold and silver coins have been so perfectly embodied that it is the most dazzling constellation in the starry Chinese gold and silver coins.

2001年中國人民銀行開始發行中國石窟藝術繫列金銀紀念幣,自敦煌石窟起,龍門石窟次,麥積山石窟再,至雲岡石窟終。四大石窟,10年跨度,18個品種,10金8銀,精美的雕刻,深刻的細節,深厚的文化內涵在中國石窟藝術金銀幣上得到了如此完美的體現,它是群星璀璨的中國金銀幣中那最耀眼的一個星座。

### —. The Position of Chinese Cave Art Gold and Silver Coins in the History of China's Gold and Silver Coin Development

#### 一、中國石窟藝術金銀幣在中國金銀幣發展歷史中的位置

If we analyze the history of gold and silver coinage in China, we will find that from the 1990s onwards, Chinese gold and silver coins have entered an era where the finest coins have been produced in abundance. The number of coins issued, the wide range of coins, and the abundance of high-quality products are breathtaking. The issuance of the Cave Art Gold and Silver Coins is the most climactic, brilliant and artistically expressive chapter in this magnificent period of gold and silver coin issuance.

In the Klaus World Coin Awards, which is known as "the Oscars of the numismatic world", Chinese gold and silver coins have been issued for 38 years, and a total of 10 coins have won the awards. In the 38 years of the Chinese gold and silver coins being issued, a total of 10 coins were awarded. The excellent artistic appeal of the Cave Art Linked Gold and Silver Coins has also touched the hearts of international numismatists. It should be noted that the Cave Art Series is the only gold and silver coin item outside the category of "old, fine and rare" to win the Klaus Prize, and it is also the last item that China has won the Klaus Prize so far. Since 2004, when the Maijishan 5 ounce gold coin won the "Best Gold Coin" at the World Coin Awards, there have been no more Chinese gold and silver coins winning the Klaus Prize.

在享有"錢幣界中的奧斯卡"美譽之稱的克勞斯世界硬幣大獎中,中國金銀幣發行38載,共有10枚硬幣獲獎。而石窟藝術繫列金銀幣居然有2枚。石窟藝術繫列金銀幣優秀的藝術魅力也打動了國際錢幣專家的心。需要註意的是,石窟藝術繫列是唯一在"老精稀"範疇之外獲得克勞斯大獎的金銀幣項目,也是中國到目前為止獲得克勞斯大獎的最後一個項目。自2004年麥積山5盎司金幣獲得世界硬幣大獎"最佳金幣"之後,中國金銀幣再無斬獲。

#### 二、The Beauty of Cave Art Gold and Silver Coins

#### 二、石窟藝術金銀幣之美

The Cave Art Linked Gold and Silver Coin is so beautiful, beautiful in her subject matter, beautiful in her design, beautiful in her carvings, and beautiful in the story behind her.

- (—) The Beauty of Caves
- (一) 石窟的美

Grottoes are monasteries built on rocks and cliffs and originated in India. India is located in the South Asian subcontinent, the climate is hot and humid, the rainy season is long, these factors are not conducive to the practice of meditation. Therefore, at a very early stage, Indians chose to live and meditate in natural caves, which are warm in the winter and cool in the summer, in order to train themselves physically and mentally. This method of construction was later spread to China, and Buddhism has made it famous.

石窟是營建在巖石、山崖上的寺院,源於印度。由於印度所處的南亞次大陸氣候濕熱,雨季漫長,這些因素都不利於修行。故此在很早期,印度人就選擇了在冬暖夏涼的天然巖洞中起居打坐,錘煉自己的身心。這種建築方法其後傳至中國,而佛教將之發揚光大。

Cave art is a remarkable art treasure that unites deep religious feelings, embodies a distinctive contemporary style, and presents a complete historical picture. Cave art is a combination of the essence of heaven and earth, the spirit of mankind, and the essence of Chinese and foreign cultures. It is full of richness and richness, but it is not heavy and obscure; on the contrary, its lively visual images are pleasing to the eyes and make people express their feelings. Dunhuang Mogao Grottoes, Longmen Grottoes, Maijishan Grottoes and Yungang Grottoes are known as the "Four Great Grottoes of China".

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石窟藝術是卓越的藝術珍品,它凝聚了深厚的宗教感情,體現了鮮明的時代風尚,展示了一段完整的歷史畫卷。石窟藝術兼得天地精華與人間靈氣,融會中外的文化精粹,飽滿渾厚,但併不沈重晦澀,反而其活潑的視覺形象能悅人眼目,令人抒懷賞心。敦煌莫高窟、龍門石窟、麥積山石窟和雲岡石窟,便素有"中國四大石窟"之稱。

Cave art is, to a certain extent, the art of the environment. The environment can provide a suitable place for grotto statues and emphasize the artistic effect of the statues. Almost without exception, the grottoes are located in beautiful mountainous areas far away from the bustling city, the environment itself gives people a feeling of paradise, which is in line with the Buddhist idea of abandoning emotions and washing away desires, and longing for the other side of the Buddha's netherworld.

- (二) The design and sculptural beauty of the Cave Art Gold and Silver Coins
  - (二) 石窟藝術金銀幣的設計和雕刻美

Mogao Caves in Dunhuang, Gansu 敦煌莫高窟

The Mogao Grottoes at Dunhuang are the world's largest surviving "treasure house of art" and in December 1987 were listed as a World Heritage Site by UNESCO. The art of the Mogao Caves is characterized by the organic combination of architecture, statues and murals. Cave formations, sculptures, murals, a wide variety of systematically reflecting more than ten dynasties and various aspects of cultural exchanges between the East and the West, and has become a rare cultural treasure of mankind. Since the discovery of more than 50,000 volumes of religious and secular documents in the Mogao Cave on May 26, 1900, Dunhuang art has shaken the world, and "Dunhuang Studies"

敦煌莫高窟是現存規模最龐大的"世界藝術寶庫",一九八七年十二月被聯合國教科文組織列為世界文化遺產。莫高窟藝術的特點錶現在建築、塑像和壁畫三者的有機結合上。窟形建制、雕塑、壁畫種類繁多,繫統反映了十多個朝代及東西方文化交流的各個方面,成為人類稀有的文化寶藏。自1900年5月26日莫高窟藏經洞中發現五萬多卷宗教和世俗文書後,敦煌藝術震撼了整個世界,"敦煌學"已成為世界性的顯學。

In 2001, the People's Bank of China issued the gold and silver commemorative coins of "Cave Art of China - Dunhuang". In this set of 3 gold and 2 silver coins, the 2 ounce silver coin "Sheng Tang Bodhisattva" is a masterpiece of design and engraving, it is so outstanding, so glittering. Even in the dazzling light of the many gold and silver coins of the entire cave art program, it is still the most brilliant star. It can be said that this coin is one of the finest in the Chinese gold and silver coin industry since 2000. It also won the "Best Silver Coin" award at the 2003 Krause World Coin Awards.

2001年,中國人民銀行發行"中國石窟藝術·敦煌"金銀紀念幣。在這一套3金2銀的紀念幣中,2盎司規格的銀幣"盛唐菩薩像"集設計與雕刻之大成,它是如此優秀,如此熠熠生輝。即便是在整個石窟藝術項目眾多金銀幣精品的耀眼光芒中,依然是最光彩奪目的那一顆星。可以說,這枚幣是2000年以後中國金銀幣行業最優秀的一枚銀幣。它也因此獲得2003年克勞斯世界硬幣大獎"最佳銀幣"獎。

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A closer look at this coin, only to see the Buddha face like the moon, eyebrows like a bow, smooth skin, elegant demeanor, in the mirror background, the more solemn and solemn. In order to realize the Bodhisattva's compassion for all beings in the world, the designer also deliberately shaped the Bodhisattva's facial expression to be more solemn and compassionate.

The silver coin is made in high relief and sandblasted, and the surface of the coin is white with a large area of mirror, with distinctive layers. Looking at the coin from afar, a Bodhisattva is sitting in the moonlight, which makes people feel like worshipping.

銀幣採用無邊高浮雕及噴砂工藝,幣面採用大面積鏡面留白,層次分明。遠遠望去 ,一尊菩薩端坐於皓月之中,讓人不由得心生膜拜之意。

This coin is a monumental example of China's superb gold and silver coin minting techniques, with virtually impeccable mirror, sandblasted, reverse sandblasted, high-relief and curved embossing techniques.

這枚幣體現了我國金銀幣高超的鑄造工藝,其鏡面、噴砂、反噴砂、高浮雕和曲面 壓印工藝幾乎無可挑剔,堪稱不朽之作。

Another important reason why this coin is so beautiful is that it comes from a famous family. The reverse design is based on the Buddha's right side of the famous Cave 328 at Dunhuang, where the main Buddha, Shakyamuni, is surrounded by his attendant Bodhisattvas. The design is by Mr. Du Yongwei, a famous sculptor and researcher of Dunhuang art.

這枚幣之所以如此精美,還有一個重要原因是出自名門。背面圖案取材於敦煌著名的328窟主尊釋迦牟尼佛右側的脅侍菩薩。而圖案設計者則是著名的雕塑家和敦煌藝術研究大家杜永衛先生。

Cave 328 of Mogao Grottoes is a watch-making cave that was excavated in the early Tang Dynasty. The top of the cave and the four walls are painted with thousands of Buddhas, repainted in Western Xia. This cave statues, fine production, realistic, both God and form, is a fine Tang sculpture. In the center of the Buddha for the Dharma phase of the solemn and dignified, graceful and generous, through the folds of the dress skirt, the Buddha light and the Buddha sat in the careful carving, brilliant and colorful. Two large bodhisattvas sitting in a game seat style, beautiful and natural posture, rich skin, gorgeous clothes, soft and dignified modeling, showing the wisdom and depth of the Bodhisattva. Ananda was wearing a gorgeous robe, body slightly slanting, hands caged in the sleeves, head held high as if listening to the Dharma, attitude free, magnificent as hesitant and full of ambition of the noble young man. Gayatri's eyebrows locked, skinny and bony, old and dignified, if a life of hardship and weathered the quiet old man. Kneeling on both sides of the half-supported Bodhisattva pious quiet. In the Mogao Grottoes existing more than two thousand colored sculptures, the original sculpture retained in various eras of more than one hundred and forty bodies, most of the rest of the later generations of repainting or remodeling. The group of statues in the west wall of Cave 328 are all original works of the Tang Dynasty and have high artistic value.

莫高窟第328窟是開鑿於初唐時期的代錶洞窟。窟頂、四壁壁畫均為仟佛,西夏重繪。此窟塑像,制作精細,神態逼真,形神兼備,是唐塑中的精品。居中作說法相的佛像莊嚴肅穆、雍容大度,通過對衣褶垂裙、佛光和佛坐的精心刻畫,顯得燦爛多彩。兩身大菩薩坐遊戲座式,姿態優美自然,肌膚豐潤,衣飾華麗,造型柔麗端莊,錶現菩薩的智慧和深沈。阿難身著華麗袈裟,身軀微斜,雙手籠於袖內,昂首挺立似在出神聆聽佛法,意態灑脫,壯若躊躇滿誌的華貴少年。迦葉雙眉緊鎖,瘦骨嶙峋,老成持重,若坎坷一生飽經風霜的沈靜老人。兩側半跪的供養菩薩虔誠文靜。在莫高窟現存的兩仟多身彩塑中,各個時代保留的雕塑原作有一百四十余身,其余大都經過後代重繪或重塑。第328窟西壁佛龕內的群像,均為唐代原作,具有很高的藝術價值。

When we appreciate this 2-ounce silver coin, we can find something very interesting by comparing the prototype of the pattern. Looking at this 2 ounce silver coin, the Bodhisattva on the face of the coin has an elegant and casual demeanor, which is very feminine, but there are no obvious female features on her body.

This kind of depiction on the coin can easily make people sleepy. If we study the prototype sculpture carefully, we will find that on the face of the original Bodhisattva, there is an obvious beard. By comparison, we know that at least in the early Tang Dynasty, bodhisattvas in China were still portrayed as male. In fact, in the early days of Buddhism, all Bodhisattvas were indeed male, and it was only after they were introduced into China and adapted to the requirements of Chinese localization that they gradually became feminized. The most successful transformation was the "Avalokiteshvara".

我們在欣賞這枚2盎司銀幣的時候,通過對比圖案的原型,可以發現一些很有意思的事情。看這枚2盎司銀幣,幣面上的菩薩體態舉止優雅、閑適,很具有女性化的意味,但是身體併無明顯的女性特徵。幣面上的這種刻畫是容易讓人產生睏惑的。仔細研究原型雕塑,我們會發現,在原作的菩薩面容上,有著明顯的胡須。通過對比,我們知道,起碼在初唐時期,在中國菩薩依然是以男性的形象示人。實際上,在佛教的早期,所有菩薩確實均為男性,只是在傳入中國後,為適應中國本地化要求,菩薩才漸漸有了女性化的傾嚮。轉變最成功的要數"觀世音菩薩"了。

In addition, the right hand of the Bodhisattva is missing in the original work, but in the face of the coin, the missing part was artificially added for the sake of artistic expression. Looking closely at the artificially replaced part of the coin's face, there is still a sense of incongruity. In the design of gold and silver coins, should we respect the original appearance of the coins or allow appropriate artistic processing? It is indeed necessary for designers to carefully consider how to strike a balance between the requirements of the subject matter, the physical prototype and the artistic creation.

另外,原作中菩薩的右手是殘缺的,在幣面中,為了藝術錶現力,人為的把殘缺部分補了上去。細看幣面圖案這截人為補上去的部分,還是有些不協調之感。在金銀幣的設計中,幣面圖案是尊重實物原貌呢,還是允許適當的藝術加工?如何把握好題材要求、實物原型和藝術創作之間的平衡,這確實需要設計師仔細斟酌。

Another thing that must be said is that in Cave 328, on the same side as the prototype Buddha on the 2-ounce coin, there is a half-kneeling offering Buddha missing. This Buddha was stolen by American Warners in 1924 and is now in the Sackler Museum at Harvard University.

另外,不得不說的一件事是,在328窟內,與2盎司銀幣圖案原型菩薩同側,缺少了一個半跪的供養菩薩。這尊菩薩在1924年被美國人華爾納盜走,現存於美國哈佛大學賽克勒博物館。

品讀這枚敦煌2盎 司銀幣,品讀幣 背後的故事,猶 如品一杯陳年的 美酒,回味無窮

The Maijishan grottoes 麥積山石窟

The Maijishan Grottoes are located on a lonely peak in the Western Qinling Mountains, 50 kilometers southeast of Tianshui City, Gansu Province, south of Maijishan Township, and are named after their resemblance to a stack of wheat. The Maijishan Grottoes were first created in the 16th Dynasty of the Later Qin Dynasty (384-417 A.D.), and have been repaired and enlarged several times since then, and were basically completed in the Sui Dynasty at the end of the 6th century A.D., and have been preserved in their entirety to this day. The Maijishan Grottoes were built in 384 A.D. and have been continuously excavated and restored over ten dynasties, making them one of the most famous large-scale grottoes in China and a world-famous treasure trove of art. There are now 194 caves, including more than 7,200 clay and stone sculptures from the 4th to the 19th centuries, and more than 1,300 square meters of frescoes. Historian Fan Wenlan once described the Maijishan Caves as "a great exhibition hall of statues".

麥積山石窟地處甘肅省天水市東南方50公裏的麥積山鄉南側西秦嶺山脈的一座孤峰上,因其形似麥垛而得名。麥積山石窟始創於十六國後秦(公元384年至417年),爾後屢有修葺擴建,至公元六世紀末的隋代基本建成,併完整保留至今。麥積山石窟建自公元384年,後來經過十多個朝代的不斷開鑿、重修,遂成為中國著名的大型石窟之一,也是聞名世界的藝術寶庫。現存洞窟194個,其中有從4世紀到19世紀以來的歷代泥塑、石雕7200余件,壁畫1300多平方米。歷史學家範文瀾曾譽麥積山為"陳列塑像的大展覽館"。

In 2004, the People's Bank of China issued the gold and silver commemorative coins of "China's Cave Art - Maijishan", with two gold and one silver coin. Among the three coins, the 5 ounce gold coin is the one with the highest artistic achievement. The back of the coin is designed by Mr. Luo Yonghui, a famous coin designer in China, and engraved by Mr. Wang Yunye, a young artist. The combination of the two artists has given this coin a profound artistic impact, and with its unique design and exquisite minting, it has once again impressed the judges of the Klaus World Coin Awards and won the "Best Gold Coin" award of the 2006 World Coin Awards.

2004年中國人民銀行發行"中國石窟藝術·麥積山"金銀紀念幣,2金1銀。在這三枚紀念幣當中,藝術造詣最高的當屬5盎司金幣。該幣背面圖案設計者為我國著名的錢幣設計藝術大師羅永輝先生,雕刻者為青年藝術家王雲野先生。兩位藝術家珠聯璧合,使得此枚金幣具有深厚的藝術感染力,併且以獨特的設計和精美的鑄造,再次打動克勞斯世界硬幣大獎評委的心,榮獲2006年世界硬幣大獎"最佳金幣"獎。

The obverse of this 5 ounce gold coin features a panoramic view of the Maijishan Grottoes, while the reverse features a seated Buddha and a flying sky in the Maijishan Grottoes. The obverse design adopts the traditional sandblasting and polishing techniques to represent the geographical and human characteristics of the Maijishan landscape, emphasizing the texture of the gravel rocks and the lushness of the trees, and using simple and plain artistic language to present the three-bodied cliff statues, the dense caves, and the vertical and horizontal trekking paths in a clear and distinctive manner, and at the same time, the mountain peaks rising up into the clouds in the picture make the Maijishan Mountain appear even more spectacular and majestic.

這枚5盎司金幣正面圖案為麥積山石窟全景,背面圖案為麥積山石窟坐佛像和飛天圖案。正面圖案採用傳統的噴砂、拋光工藝來錶現麥積山外景的地理特徵和人文特徵,強調了砂礫巖的質感和樹木的蔥郁,以簡潔樸素的藝術語言將三身摩崖造像、繁密的洞窟、縱橫的棧道錶現得清晰有致,同時畫面中聳入雲端的山峰使麥積山顯得更加蔚為壯觀與雄奇。

The back of the coin features the main Buddha statue from Cave 44, and the relief treatment is faithful to the original to the greatest extent possible. Based on the characteristics of the Maijishan Caves, where most of the statues are clay sculptures that are delicately carved with great interest, the statue in the coin is a perfect likeness of the original, and it truly reproduces the artistic style of the Maijishan Caves.

金幣背面圖案選自第44窟主佛造像,其浮雕處理最大程度地忠實原作,根據麥積山石窟造像多為泥塑刻畫入微、情趣橫生的特點,使紀念幣中的造像與原作相比惟妙惟肖,真實地再現了麥積山石窟的藝術風格。

The early statues of the Lord Buddha in the Shanxi and Wei dynasties in Maijia Shanxi are dominated by the image of motherhood, with a sense of kingship and nobility, and a graceful and glowing appearance and posture. One of the most outstanding statues is the main wall statue of Buddha in Cave 44. It is not only the culmination of the Western Wei clav Buddha art, but also the supreme work of the Northern Dynasties' grottoes.

麥積山西魏早期造像中的主佛以母性形象為主,頗具幾分王者和貴族之氣,懿容與 風姿雍容華貴,光彩照人。其中最為傑出的一尊塑像當屬第44窟正壁主佛像。它不 僅是西魏泥塑佛像藝術之巔峰,也是北朝石窟造像中的至尊之作。

The Buddha is about 1.6 meters tall, with his head in a high bun, wearing a monk's robe, a knot on his chest, and a shoulder robe, sitting in a half cross-legged position. The chignon, chest, and skirt all have traces of colorful paintings remaining on them, and the pleats of the overhanging garment in front of the Buddha's seat are all rounded and turned into lines, with the thickness of the texture and the elegance of the lines blending together, which is not only varied but also smooth and natural, with distinct layers and rich decorative interest. The hands of the Fearless and Wish Seal, though delicate and soft, give infinite comfort and harmony. The foot between the petal-like train of the garment is rounded and holy, signifying the purity of the Buddha's inner mind. The Buddha's face is moderately square and rounded, with a wise and deep spirit revealed between the eyebrows. The nose is high and straight,

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connected to the broad forehead, and it can be seen that this statue of the Lord Buddha has gradually made the transition from the "beautiful bones and clear face," (Xie He, "Ancient Paintings and Records") to the richness of the Sui and Tang dynasties.


佛高約1.6米,頭上做右水渦紋高肉髻,內穿僧祗支,胸前繫結,外披通肩袈裟,半結跏趺坐。肉髻、胸前、衣裙上均殘存彩繪痕跡,覆於佛座前的懸裳衣褶俱呈圓轉的線條,質感的厚重與線條的飄逸融為一體,既富於變化又舒暢自然,層次分明,且富有裝飾趣味。施無畏和與願印的雙手,雖然纖細柔美,但給人無限的慰藉與和順的力量。花瓣般的衣裾間露出一足,圓潤而聖潔,昭示佛之內心的純淨無染。佛面形方圓適中,眉宇間透露出睿智而深沈的靈氣。鼻梁高而修直,與寬寬的額頭相連,可以看出此尊主佛像已逐步從"秀骨清相,懍懍若對神明"(謝赫《古畫品錄》)嚮隋唐的豐腴過渡。

While the above highlights some of the typical fine examples from the Dunhuang and Maijishan Grottoes gold and silver coins, there are in fact many other masterpieces of art that deserve to be savored and studied, such as the 1kg silver coins from the Longmen Grottoes and the 1/2 ounce gold coins from the Yungang Grottoes, to name just a few. These gold and silver coins are all exquisite in their shallow-relief carvings, showcasing the vastness and depth of China's grotto art in all its splendor. The gold and silver coins of Dunhuang Grottoes, Lungmen Grottoes, Maijishan Grottoes and Yungang Grottoes can be regarded as the best of the best in terms of the recreation of the prototypes of grotto art.

以上重點賞析了敦煌石窟和麥積山石窟金銀幣項目中的典型精品,實際上在整個石窟繫列金銀幣中,還有很多藝術佳作值得細細品味和研究,例如龍門石窟的1公斤銀幣和雲岡石窟的1/2盎司金幣等等。這些金銀幣都通過精美的淺浮雕藝術,將我國石窟藝術的博大精深展現的淋漓精致。縱觀敦煌石窟、龍門石窟、麥積山石窟和雲岡石窟金銀紀念幣,件件都可以堪稱石窟藝術原型再創作的佳品。

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## QDB-R. B.White: 品質+氣質的化學效應

The auction of the copper coins has generated much excitement among collectors and enthusiasts since the end of last year. The last time copper coins received such attention was a decade ago at the Norman Yagkes special event. Despite being poorly categorized and auctioned, the appearance of many rare copper coin treasures set numerous records.

如果有人想帶著賺快錢的思路,在2018年QDB-R.B.White專場有所斬獲的話,恐怕會從開始失望到底,這是現場很多幣商和藏家的共同體會。 因為在經過了波瀾不驚的古錢部分后,由SBP創始人QDB先生遞藏自R.B.White、堪稱近20年來具里程碑式的銅元專場,從一開始的安徽部分開始,就幾乎奠定了整場的走勢,在不斷漸入佳境的同時,整場高潮迭出。

This auction holds special significance for many copper coin enthusiasts, as it was the event that sparked their interest in collecting back in 2008. The influence of renowned experts and high-quality coins showcased at that time had a lasting impact. Despite facing market fluctuations and challenges in the coin industry in 2011, a dedicated group of copper coin collectors emerged. Though relatively small in scale, this group has become influential within the realm of copper coin collecting. While there are still areas for improvement in terms of organization and activities, the Copper Coin Association has remained one of the most influential platforms for exchange among collectors in the country for over a decade.

從去年內地秋拍后,首席陸續發佈的QDB亮點就可以得知,這一場銅元的檔次及品質無容置疑,由淮字二十文、四川當三十領銜的品種+品相兼備的銅元,讓很多銅元藏家、玩家從去年底一直興奮了很長一段時間。 上一次銅元如此被重視還要回溯到10年前的諾曼雅格斯專場,儘管被不專業的分類上拍,但諸多銅元珍品的不斷亮相,更是創造了不少成交記錄。

The variety and condition of the coins in this auction far surpass those of the 2008 Norman Yagkes event, which has garnered the attention of top scholars and players, earning its reputation as a milestone in copper coin auctions. The auction has attracted the participation and attention of elite collectors and scholars from around the world, evident from the bustling pre-exhibition the previous day.

With such anticipation, it is believed that this significant auction will inject new life and vitality into the still relatively underdeveloped sector of copper coin collecting.

可以說,很多銅元愛好者的收藏啟蒙便來自於2008年的諾曼雅格斯專場,名家名品的效應,在此後很長一段時間持續產生著影響。 而歷經了2011年前後錢幣市場波折的洗禮與沉澱,更是從機制幣收藏圈分化出、穩定住了一支規模不大,但十分具影響力的銅元收藏群體。 儘管組織與活動本身仍有諸多不足,但已經持續十多年的銅元會至今是國內最具影響力的交流活動之一。

From a short-term investment perspective, it may be challenging to satisfy buyers with the auction results. In one word: expensive! When comparing the current market prices, many common varieties with good conditions are far surpassing market prices by more than double. Even slightly better varieties with decent conditions are priced more than 30% above market value. Higher-tier varieties can be divided into two categories: regular grades are priced significantly above market value, while rare and extremely scarce varieties continue to set new records.

正因為如此,這場在品種、品相上遠超2008年諾曼雅格斯的銅元集藏,才被諸多頂 尖的學者、玩家所重視,並被譽為里程碑式的銅元專場拍賣。 事實上,這場拍賣也 吸引了海內外頂級藏家、學者的到場關注,從前一天火爆的預展就可見一斑。 而這 也讓人更加期待這個專場的表現,相信如此重要的一場拍賣,一定會給這個仍然薄 弱的機制幣分支,注入新的血液與活力。

Whether through live bidding, online bidding, or telephone commission, the astonishing prices have left many people bewildered. However, there is little negativity evident from the atmosphere at the venue or the expressions of buyers. It is widely understood that such market conditions are difficult to sustain, especially for copper coin collecting, which still struggles to gain robust momentum. Therefore, it is worth examining what has contributed to this "feverish" demand, as tangible, convincing investments require substantial financial commitment.

或許從短期投資的角度來說,這場得標的拍品還難以讓人買家滿意。 如果非要用成交價來衡量的話,就一個字: 貴! 如果粗略對比一下當下行情的話,很多普通品種+好品相,很大一部分超過目前市場價一倍有餘。

而品種略好+品相過得去,也差不多基本要高於市場價30%。 一二三級的高端品種中,也可分為兩部分,常規等級的價格也明顯高於市場價,而珍稀、極罕見的品種,則創造一個又一個記錄。

One thing is certain: the overall quality of this batch of copper coins is exceptionally high and representative. The Huaizi Twenty-wen coin represents an extremely rare top-quality artifact, while the Sichuan Dang Thirty coin signifies the epitome of noble lineage. The Yuan Shikai bust coin represents the ultimate beauty of mechanism coins. Furthermore, the renowned R.B. White and the elusive figures of collectors like Woodhua, Farouk, and Edgar add to the depth and weight of this seemingly thin catalog. This auction has become a feast for copper coin collectors and enthusiasts and a financial harvesting machine.

無論是現場出價還是網上競投、或是電話委託,令人驚歎的價格讓很多人難以理解。 但無論從現場的氣氛,還是買家的表情來看,你都很難看到太多消極的元素。 誰都知道,對當下仍然不算景氣的銅元收藏來說,這樣的現象很難具有代表性,因為很多人都知道這樣的行情難以為繼。 所以說,究竟是什麼讓很多人變得如此"狂熱",這一點值得關注,不管什麼原因,真金白銀是最具說服力的。

In essence, this auction meets the ultimate expectations of collectors and enthusiasts, providing top-quality collectibles coupled with the secretive charm of the collectors behind them. This combination quickly creates a fascinating chemical reaction. It is possible that this effect lacks universality and may even violently disrupt current market trends, leaving many puzzled. From an investment return perspective, it is undoubtedly challenging to deem it successful, and short-term liquidity remains elusive for many common varieties.

有一點是肯定的,這批銅元的整體品質極高、並且極具代表性,如果說淮字二十文代表了珍稀至極的頂級重器,四川當三十便代表著了極致高貴的血統,而袁世凱大面像則代表了機制銅元的極致之美,加上R.B.White盛名,若隱若現的伍德華、法魯克、埃德加等藏家的身影,使得這場雖然圖錄薄薄、但是又很厚重的專場,成為銅元藏家、玩家們盛宴,更成為一台現金流的收割機。



However, no one can deny that this auction will continue to impact the market for a long time, drawing the attention of insiders and outsiders alike and stimulating contemplation among players across various levels. In an era where being a materialistic collector is increasingly challenging, it raises the question of what makes coin collecting interesting. Not everyone has the ability and opportunity to compete for rare varieties, but a collector who quietly accumulates their favorite pieces over decades, appreciates and studies them, and ultimately showcases them at the most suitable time, deserves admiration.

簡單來說,這個專場滿足了藏家們、玩家們對收藏的一切極致體驗需求,藏品本身的頂尖品質,和背後藏家的隱秘氣質,混合在一起,迅速產生令人著迷的化學效應。可能這樣的效應,不具備普遍性和參考性,甚至說比較暴力地打破了目前的基本行情,甚至會引起不少人的不解。 因為,單純從投資回報的角度來說,肯定不能算成功,甚至一些普通品種,很難在短期內套現。

For collectors who have built their collections over several decades, the good auction prices not only provide a rewarding return on their perseverance but also serve as valuable references and guidance for newcomers. The accumulation of visual acuity and experience during the collection process, coupled with personal taste and correct values in collecting, will ultimately lead to a double harvest of both material and spiritual rewards!

但誰都無法否認,這個專場會在此後很長時間內不斷產生著效應,吸引了諸多圈內 圈外人的關注,引發著不同層級玩家的思考,在這個越來越難成為物質大藏家的時 代,什麼的錢幣收藏才算有趣。 不是每個人都有能力和機會去角逐那些珍稀品種, 但一個藏家能夠默默集藏自己的喜愛數十年,體會、研究其中的樂趣,並最終選擇 最適合的時間綻放或大或小的精彩,本身就值得讚賞。

Lastly, a noteworthy detail about the auction: the QDB special event featured a total of 353 lots and lasted from 9:30 am to nearly 9 pm. This became one of SBP's slowest-recorded auctions. Known for its fast-paced nature, the intense and frequent bidding process in this auction significantly elongated its duration, surpassing 600 lots. While the majority of observers may not have achieved their desired results, the opportunity for copper coin enthusiasts to experience this captivating event in person is undoubtedly rare and precious.

最後,介紹一下拍賣中的一個小細節:此次QDB專場共計353項拍品,從早上9點半開拍,到晚上近9點鐘結束,幾乎創造了SBP拍賣時間的最慢記錄。 因為SBP以往的拍賣節奏本身以快著稱,但此次買家的加價過程激烈、頻繁,愣是拉長到了600多項的效果。 可能絕大部分關注者未必都有如意的收穫,但對銅元愛好者來說,能現場體驗這種專場的精彩,確實是非常難得而寶貴的經歷。





The earliest one-dollar banknote in Hong Kong was issued by the Hongkong and Shanghai Banking Corporation (now known as HSBC) in 1872. However, the early banknotes were printed with the words "HSBC". So what exactly does that mean? In fact, the bank clearly tells us through its name that its business is mainly focused on remittances (HS in Chinese) and financial lending (BC in Chinese).

香港最早期的壹圓鈔票是由香港上海匯理銀行(即匯豐銀行前身)於1872年發行, 但早期鈔票都印上「匯理」二字,到底甚麼是意思?

其實,銀行透過她的名字很清楚告知我們,銀行的業務就是以匯兌 (匯)和理財放貸 (理)為主。

HSBC in Hong Kong was established by foreign merchants in Hong Kong and registered in Hong Kong. It was authorized by the Hong Kong government at that time to issue banknotes in Hong Kong. Its headquarters is located in the UK, while the other five Hong Kong banks were authorized to issue banknotes in Hong Kong through the Royal Charter granted by the British royal family. According to the regulations of the Royal Charter, the banknotes issued by the banks must be equivalent to one pound and its multiples.

香港匯豐銀行是由本港外商在香港註冊成立,並由當時香港政府授權可以在本港發 鈔,其銀行總部設在英國,而其他五間香港銀行則透過英國皇室頒授的《皇家特許 狀》准予在香港發行鈔票。

根據《皇家特許狀》的規定,銀行所發行的鈔票必須等同於一英鎊及其倍數。按照一八四五年港府頒佈的官方兌換率,一英鎊可兌換五枚墨西哥鷹洋,而每枚鷹洋又等值於香港一圓,所以其它銀行的港圓鈔票都是五圓或五圓以上。

香港匯豐銀行於1872-1935年間獲香港政府獨家授權發行一圓鈔票,長達六十四年 才停止。

According to the official exchange rate issued by the Hong Kong government in 1845, one pound could be exchanged for five Mexican silver dollars, and each silver dollar was equivalent to one dollar in Hong Kong. Therefore, the banknotes of other banks in Hong Kong were five dollars or more.

HSBC in Hong Kong was exclusively authorized by the Hong Kong government to issue one-dollar banknotes for a period of 64 years from 1872 to 1935, before it ceased.

不過,其實發行壹圓鈔票並沒有想像中的順利。

當時市面上由銀行發行並流通的鈔票,銀行必須保證能兌現白銀或相等值的碎銀,英國政府曾擔心一般市民一旦因流言導致恐慌性兌換白銀,而銀行不敷應付,便會大損銀行公信力,對香港經濟帶來嚴重破壞。

However, the issuance of one-dollar banknotes was not as smooth as imagined. At that time, the banknotes issued and circulated by the banks in the market had to be guaranteed to redeem silver or an equivalent value of fractional silver. The British government was concerned that if the general public caused a panic and rushed to exchange for silver due to rumors, the banks would not be able to meet the demand, which would seriously damage the credibility of the banks and cause severe economic damage to Hong Kong.

同時香港政府為方便市民,特批准匯豐銀行發行了為數不少的壹圓鈔票,考慮到日後出現特殊狀況而需要回收鈔票(例如: 鈔票殘舊、更換設計),想必會導致市民間出現懷疑的聲音,便以書面聲明: 所有壹圓鈔票不論何時都會永遠回收。

而幸好這段時期未出現任何事故,匯豐銀行的壹圓的壽命得以維持多年。

At the same time, the Hong Kong government approved HSBC to issue a considerable number of one-dollar banknotes in order to facilitate the public. Considering that there may be special situations in the future that require the recall of banknotes (e.g. banknotes becoming worn out, design change), which may raise doubts among the public, a written declaration was made: all one-dollar banknotes will be permanently recalled regardless of when. Fortunately, there were no incidents during this period, and the lifespan of HSBC's one-dollar banknotes was maintained for many years.

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The early design of the one-yuan banknote of the Hongkong and Shanghai Banking Corporation (HSBC) between 1872-1888 featured only the bank's emblem. The design resembled that of a check, with slightly larger dimensions of 129 x 180mm, hence it was referred to as the "big check".

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During the period from 1889 to 1899, the design of the check was largely the same, with the only changes being in color and size. This period is commonly referred to as the "small check" period, with the size measuring 86 x 134mm.

1889-1899年間,設計基本沿用支票樣式,

但改變了顏色及尺寸,故此這段時間就稱為「細支票」,尺寸為86 x 134mm

Between 1904 and 1925, the design of banknotes included images of the Britannia goddess and characters from mythological fables. However, at that time, there were no specific anti-counterfeiting designs, and the dimensions of the banknotes were 90 x 131mm. This version of the banknotes had English text on the front, with a semi-arched design (arch bridge between 1904-1913) and a normal horizontal design (straight bridge between 1923-1925). The accompanying image is of the straight bridge version.

1904-1925年間,鈔票設計增加了不列顛尼亞女神像和神話寓言的人物圖案。 但當時仍未有特別針對防偽的設計,其尺寸為90 x 131mm 此版別鈔票,正面英文分別有半拱形(拱橋1904-13期間)及正常橫向(直橋1923-25期間)設計,



During the period from 1926 to 1935, although the design continued to use the image of the Britannia goddess, it was the first time that a window watermark appeared, becoming the earliest anti-counterfeiting feature of Hong Kong banknotes. Its size is 90 x 131mm.

During the period from 1872 to 1904, all banknotes of The Hongkong and Shanghai Banking Corporation required the personal signature of a high-ranking bank officer. However, from 1906 to 1935, the one dollar banknotes were printed with machine signatures, eliminating the need for manual signing. At the same time, the size of the banknotes also got progressively smaller.

1872-1904年間,香港匯豐銀行所有面值鈔票均需由銀行大班親筆簽名, 直到1906-1935年的壹圓鈔票就全部轉成印刷簽名(機簽)。同時鈔票的面積亦愈 來愈小。

In 1935, it can be considered as a turning point for the one dollar banknote. In 1929, during the Great Depression, the United States implemented a "silver purchase policy" in 1934, leading to a large outflow of silver from China and a decline in its competitiveness. In response to this, the Chinese government decided to end the silver standard in 1935, and the Hong Kong government followed suit on November 9th. All local and non-local silver coins issued by the Hong Kong government were abolished, except for the British Trade Dollar (BTD), which was still in use until 1937. From then on, the only one dollar banknotes available in the Hong Kong market were those issued by the Hongkong and Shanghai Banking Corporation (HSBC).

To maintain the circulation of currency after the discontinuation of the silver coins, the Hong Kong government decided to issue temporary one dollar paper currency on November 12th, 1935. This banknote featured the portrait of King George V and became the earliest government-issued banknote in Hong Kong, commonly referred to as the "Old Man with a Beard". The banknote was purple in color and measured 79 x 126mm. In the same year, HSBC officially stopped issuing one dollar banknotes.

1935年可以算是壹圓鈔票的轉捩點,

1929年經濟大蕭條,及後美國於1934年通過「收購白銀政策」,導致中國的白銀大量外流,商品競爭力亦因此下降。國民政府有見及此決定於1935年宣報結束銀本位,而香港政府亦緊隨其後於11月9日實拖,此前由香港政府發行的所有本地銀幣及非本地銀幣,一律廢止,英國貿易銀圓「BTD British Trade Dollar」除外,仍沿用至1937年。而香港市面上則只剩下匯豐銀行所發行的壹圓面額鈔票。

為了在銀圓停用的情況下維持貨幣的流通,香港政府決定於1935年11月12日發行臨時壹圓紙幣,這張印有英皇喬治五世人像,普羅市民稱之為「鬍鬚佬」的鈔票,就成為了香港最早的政府發行鈔票,顏色為紫色,尺寸是79 x 126mm。 匯豐銀行同年亦正式停發壹圓鈔票。

After the Japanese occupation and surrender on Christmas Day in 1941, Hong Kong endured a challenging period for three years and eight months. During this time, Hong Kong people were forced to exchange their Hong Kong dollars for Japanese military currency. According to news reports from that time, the exchange rate was four Hong Kong dollars to one Japanese military yen.

Additionally, due to the disruption in overseas transportation caused by the war, the delivery of regular banknotes was difficult. To address this issue, the government borrowed five-dollar Chinese banknotes from the Bank of China and stamped them with the red inscription "HONG KONG GOVERNMENT \$1 香港政府 壹圓". They also borrowed thousand-yen Japanese banknotes and stamped them with the same red inscription. These two types of banknotes are considered unique in the history of Hong Kong currency.

當時政府於是分別向中國銀行借用當時的伍圓鈔票加蓋上紅色「HONG KONG GOVERNMENT \$1 香港政府 壹圓」字樣,及向日本借用千円武尊圖案的鈔票加蓋印上紅色「HONG KONG GOVERNMENT \$1 香港政府 壹圓」字樣,以彌補鈔票不足的問題,上述兩種鈔票也算是香港鈔票歷史中較有特色的其中兩款。

After the Second World War, Hong Kong used a one-dollar note between 1949 and 1952. The note still featured the portrait of King George VI but its color was changed to green. The dimensions of the note remained the same at 79 x 126mm.

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In 1952, after the death of King George VI, the Hong Kong government replaced the colonial currency with banknotes featuring the portrait of Queen Elizabeth II. The banknotes maintained the green color and had dimensions of 79 x 126mm. This series of banknotes marked the end of the circulation of one-dollar banknotes in Hong Kong.

1952年,英皇喬治六世駕崩後,由於當時香港的制度仍然是遵從殖民地法, 香港政府於1952-1959年間,就換上了英女皇伊莉莎白二世的頭像, 顏色維持綠色,尺寸大小維持79 x 126mm, 而這款女皇頭像鈔票亦是香港發行並流通壹圓紙幣的終點。

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
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
